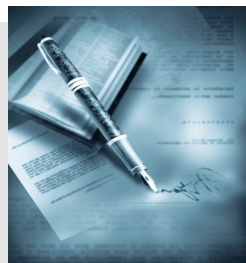

Teen Task Force-Narcotics Overdose Prevention Seminar (NOPE) at Taravella High, Co- sponsored by HOHSFL & Sawgrass Springs Middle School drew 100+ parents & teenagers!

A backdrop of 30 posters of youth, age 13-26, who are no longer living because of bad decisions, motivated listeners. Personal stories from parents who lost their children to drugs and police officers reporting tragedies touched hearts.

We were challenged to re-evaluate boundaries in the home and in our personal lives. Thank you NOPE for traveling from West Palm Beach, to make a difference in all of our lives.

We also had the honor of meeting with Congressman Allen West and shared the vision of HOHSFL.

Joyce Meyers tells us, "When God brought the Israelites across the Jordan River into the Promised Land, there was something He needed to do to prepare them to conquer and occupy their 1st town Jerico." (Battlefield of the Mind, pgs 255-260)

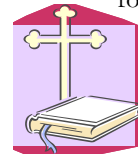
keeper, Jesus, and His blood forgiving all sins, removes the legal right of Satan to attack

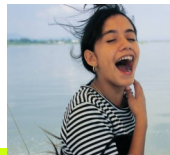
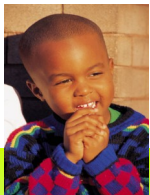
